Applicable to irrigation service furnished on a metered basis to territory in this schedule.

TERRITORY

The incorporated City of Placentia.

The Service Charge is a readiness-to-serve charge applicable to all metered service and to which is added the charge for water used computed at the Quantity Rates.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS

1. All bills are subject to the reimbursement fee set forth on Schedule No. UF.
2. The company shall not be required to install new mains to make this service available.
3. The annual service charge will be paid in advance and bills will be computed and rendered monthly based on the total quantity of water delivered.
4. The customer, when requiring irrigation water, shall notify the Company at least twenty-four (24) hours in advance, indicating the date and hour for commencement of such service.
5. No customer shall be eligible for service under this schedule unless irrigating five (5) or more acres of land for citrus or other commercial crops.
6. Service under this schedule is subordinate to all other service schedule offered in this tariff areas and is subject to interruptions in emergencies or at the Company's discretion. The Company will not be liable for damage occasioned by interruption of service supplied under this schedule.
7. The customer will pay, without refund, the actual cost of the irrigation service. The company will furnish the meter at its expense.
8. As authorized by the California Public Utilities Commission, an amount of \$0.110 per Ccf is be added to the Quantity Rate for a period of 24 months, beginning on the effective date of Advice Letter 1272-W, which is May 28, 2008. This surcharge will recover the undercollection in the Balancing-type Memorandum Account as of December 31, 2007. (D)
9. As authorized by the California Public Utilities Commission, an amount of \$0.009 per Ccf is to be added to the Quantity Rate for a period of 24 months, beginning on the effective date of Advice Letter 1381-W. This surcharge will recover the undercollection in the WRAM/MCBA Balancing Account, as of December 31, 2009.
10. Due to the increase in supply expenses, an amount of \$0.262 per Ccf is to be added to the Quantity Rates beginning on the effective date of Advice Letter 1385-W. This rate will remain in effect until the approval of the next General Rate Filing, which is Application No. 08-07-010 or Supply Expenses Offset Advice Letter, whichever comes first.
11. As authorized by the California Public Utilities Commission, an amount of \$0.06879 per Ccf is to be added to the Quantity Rate (N)
 for a period of 12 months, beginning on the effective date of Advice Letter 1401-W. This surcharge will recover the under- (N)
 collection in the CARW Balancing Account, as of December 31, 2009. (N)
